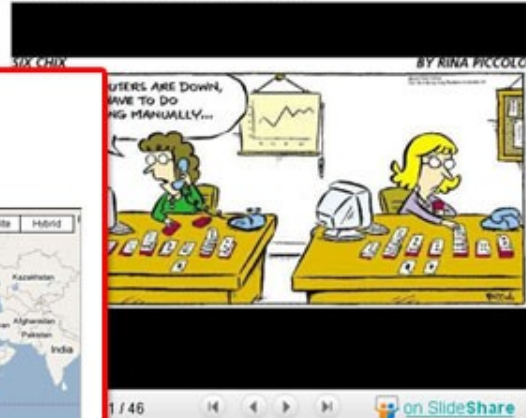

Chameleon Web 2.0 team locations

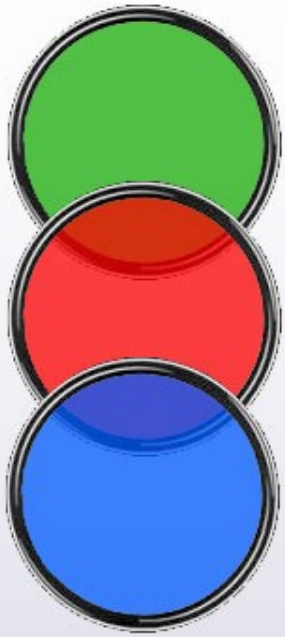

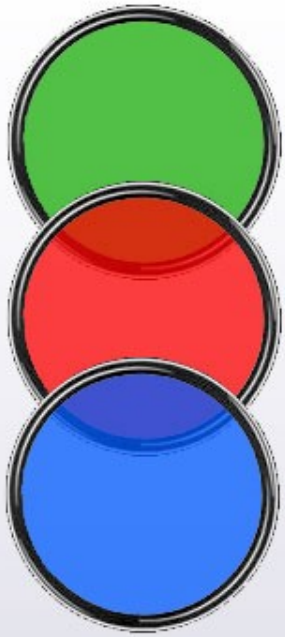
What are filters?



- A simple way to include external content in a Chisimba or KEWL content page



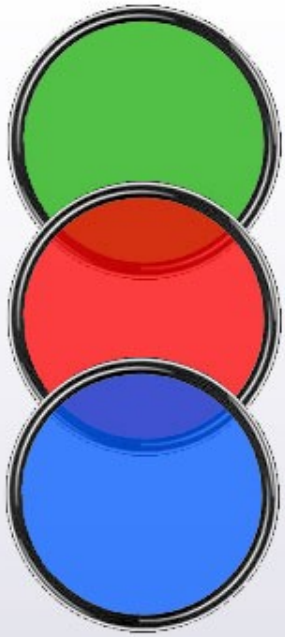
What are filters?



- Provide a markup for including external content



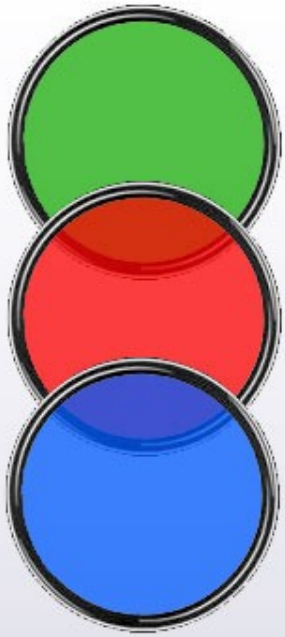
What are filters?



- Three types of filters
 - BBCode style filters
 - Wordpress style filters
 - Chisimba style filters



What are filters?



- Special filters called **chikis** (Chisimba Wiki-like codes)

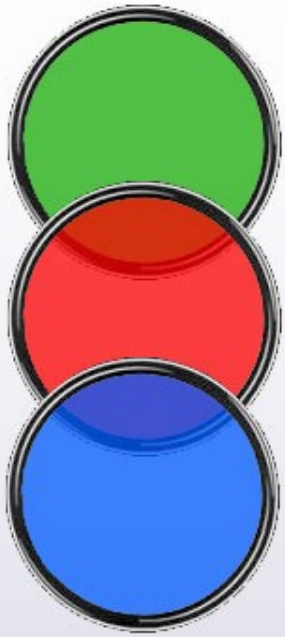

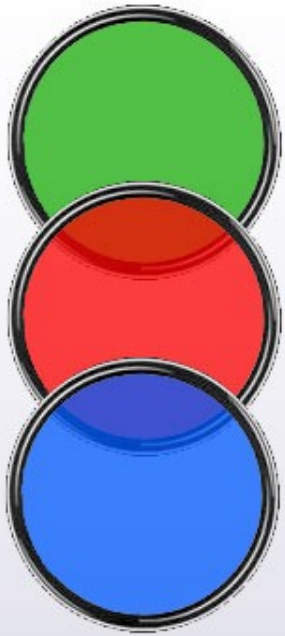
BBCode



- BBCode (Bulletin Board Code) - the lightweight markup language used to format posts in many message boards



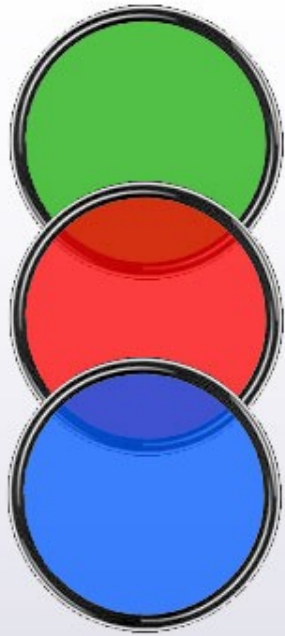
BBCode



- Has a start and an end tag similar to HTML but with square brackets as delimiters
 - e.g. [TAG][/TAG]



BBCode Filters

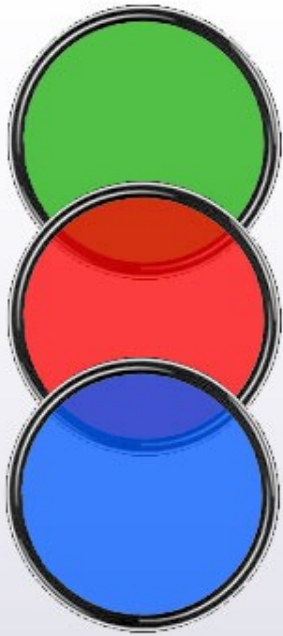


- These tags begin with the name of the tag in all upper case inside square brackets with some text between them

–e.g. **[TAG]text[/TAG]**



BBCode Filters

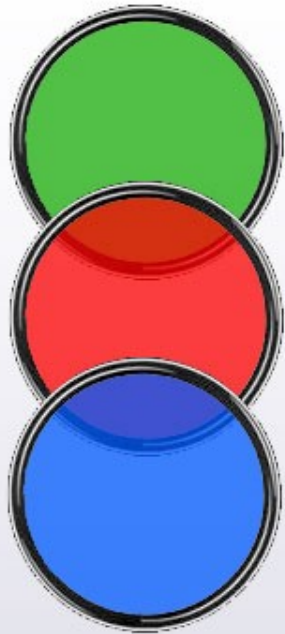


- Example: to include your tag list on del.icio.us you use

`[DELTAGS]username[/DELTAGS]`



BBCode Filters



- `[DELTAGS]username[/DELTAGS]` will insert my del.icio.us tags as shown below.

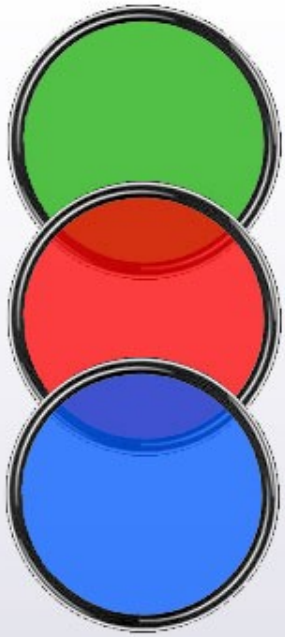

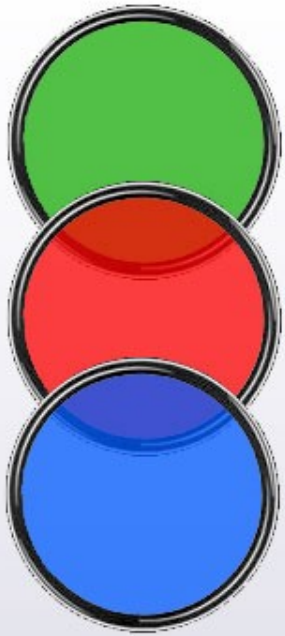
Wordpress filters



- Wordpress filters are used where a content site provides them for use in blogging and other sites running the Wordpress blogging platform



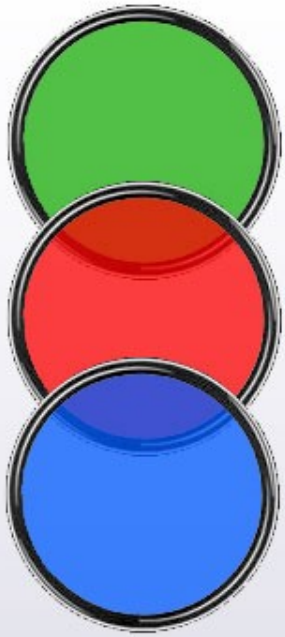
Wordpress type filters



- So far, only the Wordpress filter provided by Slideshare works in Chisimba. It takes the form
 - [slideshare [id=100417&doc=elearning-in-an-education-30-world656&w=425](#)]
- It can only be copied from the Slideshare site and pasted into Chisimba



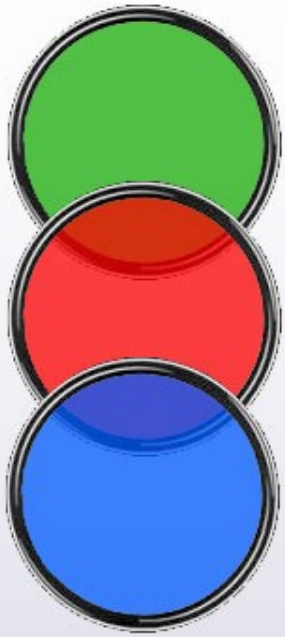
What is SlideShare?

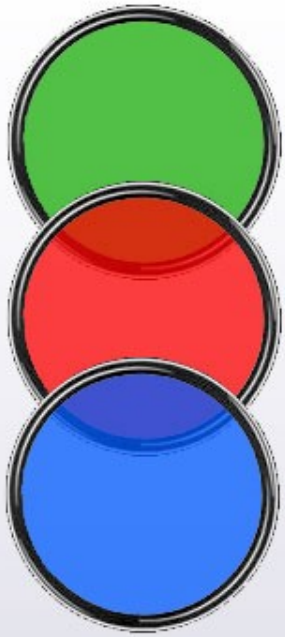
What is SlideShare?

What is SlideShare?

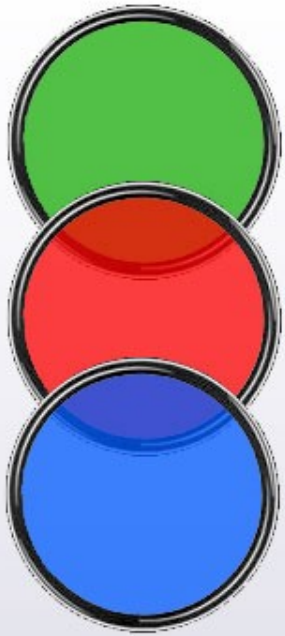


- Just like Chisimba's own presentation sharing module, a Flash plugin is required for the presentations to be seen in a web browser
